

## **Hamilton Police Departments Announces “Trade Zone” for Online Transactions**

HAMILTON – Police Chief Russ Stevens is pleased to announce that the Town of Hamilton has implemented a new program aimed at providing a safe and secure meeting place for members of the community to conduct on-line purchases.

“There can be a lot of unease created over conducting an on-line transaction. Our hope is to provide a safe public meeting area that community members can conduct their transactions. The designated “Trade Zone” area, in front of the Police Station, is properly marked, lit and video recorded so people can feel safe,” Chief Stevens said.

Community members and business owners who are engaging in an on-line transaction, can now meet at designated “Trade Zone” areas of the Police Parking Lot and conduct their business.

Chief Stevens encourages all people who engage in on-line transactions via Craigslist, Facebook or any other means, to utilize safe areas such as the one at the Hamilton Police Department while engaged in such transactions.
