The Water Department will be flushing hydrants Monday – Thursday evenings through out the Month of May. The flushing is typically performed between 9:00 p.m. to 1:00 a.m. To minimize dirty water entering your system, refrain from using water during this time. If your water appears discolored, run your cold water until it runs clear.

**Notes:**

Brush/Yard Drop Off Day is Wednesday, April 29, 2009 from 9:00 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. at the Chebacco Road (Landfill). They will accept branches, brush, grass clippings, mulch and compost. They will not accept leaves. It is open to Hamilton residents only (non-commercial).

There is one leaf collection (leaves only) this spring scheduled for Saturday, May 2, 2009. All leaves must be curbside by 7:00 a.m. and within trash cans or biodegradable paper bags.

The Annual Town Warrants were mailed to all residents on Wednesday, April 15, 2009, excluding the appendices. The appendices are available on-line and at Town Hall.

Absentee Ballots are available in the Town Clerk's office. You may vote via absentee ballot until Wednesday, May 13, 2009 at noon.
