BOARD OF SELECTMEN
FEBRUARY 22, 2011**

The Board of Selectmen met at Hamilton Town Hall at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, February 22, 2011 with William Bowler, David Carey and Jeff Stinson present. Town Manager Michael Lombardo and Fire Chief Phil Stevens also present.

Reappoint Maureen Hickey as Registrar – 3 year term (February 2014)

William Bowler entertained a motion to reappoint Maureen Hickey to a three-year term as registrar ending in February 2014. David Carey so moved. Jeff Stinson seconded motion. VOTE: Unanimous.

Introduce new call firefighters who just finished training

Fire Chief Phil Stevens introduced new call firefighters Dan Curran and Chris Allender to the Board. They have finished their training and are working on firefighter certification.

Accept gift of light poles for Patton Park from H-W Little League

Bowler entertained a motion to accept from the Hamilton-Wenham Little League a gift of \$43,000 for four light poles at Patton Park. Carey so moved. Stinson seconded the motion. VOTE: Unanimous.

Selectmen discussed with Phil Tocci, president of the H-W Little League, whether or not local businesses could post advertising signs at the baseball playing field if there was a fence that could be used for this purpose. Bowler mentioned that the zoning by-law would have to be reviewed. Tocci noted that the concession stand would be functional this season.

Accept gift of site work for lights at Patton Park from North Shore Construction, Inc.

Bowler entertained a motion to accept a gift of \$10,000 in site work from North Shore Construction, Inc. for excavation and backfilling at the baseball field

related to the installation of the lights at Patton Park. Carey so moved. Stinson seconded the motion. VOTE: Unanimous.

Sign Cemetery Deed

Selectmen signed a cemetery deed.

Accept Minutes: Regular Session: February 7, 2011

Carey entertained a motion to accept the regular session minutes for the Board of Selectmen meeting held on February 7, 2011. Bowler so moved. Stinson seconded motion. VOTE: Unanimous.
