2. Summer Recap

Sean gave a brief recap of the summer. We had 2,214 unique registrations. About 206 campers per day and 558 different campers all summer. 45 staff members and 41 C.I.Ts to run the camp. The pool had 359 memberships sold and 1,378 Drop-ins. Sean mentioned that we are trying to do some things better for next year including removing the grass inside the pool area. Looking to expand the concrete to the fence.

3. HWRHS Athletic Complex

A quick update was given as to where the high school turf project stands. A stabilization fund was voted on at town meeting. This fund can be used to fund part of the field project. The committee working on this project plans to move forward with communication and private fundraising.

4. Fall '22 Programs

Our fall '22 programs are well underway. We have brought back our toddler play group called imagination station. And most of our other programs have sufficient enrollment and are going well.

5. Bathrooms at Patton

There has been a huge issue with vandalism of the bathrooms at Patton. The last time the toilets were so clogged and the walls so messy that the cleaners needed special outfits to enter. The bathrooms have now been locked and portable restrooms brought in. Our department is looking at options for how we can keep tabs of who is going in and doing the vandalism

6. PumpkinFest

Pumpkinfest is October 29th 1-3pm at Patton Park. New this year will be a trunk or treat.

7. Wenham CPC

Sean decided to table this until our next meeting as some changes were coming for the CPC and he wanted to see how that would affect our representation on that board.
