Tree Removal Application

Approval is required from the Hamilton Conservation Commission before any work is conducted within protected wetland resource areas. Work includes removal or trimming of trees, brush, vegetation; lawn expansion; soil grading; and construction. Wetland resource areas include the 100-foot buffer zone to a wetland, pond, vernal pool, or stream and 200 feet from a river and areas under conservation restrictions.
