1. <u>NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING</u>. (CONTINUED) The Hamilton Planning Board will continue their review of a site plan application and a stormwater management application for a project proposed at 775 Bay Road by the Hamilton Wenham Regional High School. The Applicant is Superintendent Eric Tracy and represented by Consultant Kathleen Hervol, Director of Athletics, Gale Associates, Inc. The site plan review shall be as per the Hamilton Zoning Bylaw and state regulations in addition to the Hamilton stormwater management Bylaw Article XXIX as recently amended and under review by the MA Attorney General. The subject property is located at the rear of 775 Bay Road and is also known as Assessors Maps 40, Lot #11 and Map 41, Lot #1. The proposed plan is to add small structures and facilities related to an athletic facility and artificial turf fields, artificial turf tracks, tennis courts, lighting, grandstands, press-box, amenities building and ADA access improvements. Plans and reports are available electronically or can be viewed at the Planning Office, Patton Homestead, 650 Asbury Street, Hamilton, MA 01982. All wishing to speak on the matter should attend the hearing either in person or electronically via Zoom Webinar.
