All dogs 6 months or older must be registered and licensed annually per Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 140, Section 137.

- Dog licenses may be obtained at the Clerk's office, by mail, or via the website <u>www.hamiltonma.gov</u> under the "Pay Bills & Order Documents" button and then "Dog Licensing Online" button.
- Payments accepted: Online credit card or E-check; in office or by mail check only (payable to Town of Hamilton; write 'dog' in memo section)
- Proof of rabies vaccination <u>must</u> accompany this application; it will be returned to you along with your license and tag.
- Online registration requires you to upload rabies vaccination certification and proof of spay/neuter.

The Town of Hamilton has a leash law in effect which requires you to maintain control over your dog(s) at all times. Please clean up waste.
