

A Building Permit is required by Section 110.0 of the Massachusetts State Building Code (780 CMR). Anyone seeking to construct, a or demolish a structure must first obtain a building permit.

Section 201 of the Building Code indicates that permits are not needed for ordinary repairs that can be defined as "any maintenar does not affect the structure, egress, fire protection systems, fire ratings, energy conservation provisions, plumbing, sanitary, gas or other utilities." This includes painting, landscaping, adding shutters, fixing locks, working on gutters, fixing a driveway, and tiling

A permit is not needed for:

- a shed as long as it does not exceed 8 x 12' More information on sheds
- · for fences less than 7 feet \$ fences & other regulations
- · and some retaining walls.




